Raffle tickets will also be handed out in exchange for non-perishable food with prizes including a custom batch of wine, grape crush t-shirts featuring the footprints and autographs of local celebrities and many more great prizes for people who enjoy food and wine.

All food collected during the first annual Water 2 Wine Crush Week and Grape Stomp will go to Gateway Women's Services in order to help provide food for the women and children who come to Gateway looking for help escaping from the domestic violence they are experiencing in their lives. Every day Gateway Women's Services provides food for 42 women and children in the resident programs and between 400-600 women and children in the non-resident program.

With a less certain economy comes less support for charitable organizations like Gateway Women's Services which is why Water 2 Wine owner Derek Handley wanted to reach out to lend a helping hand "This is a natural fit for us [at Water 2 Wine] because we feel it is important to make a positive impact in

the local community and while we take some time to enjoy some great wine and some great food we want to help people who can't imagine taking food for granted." While the fall is traditionally the time to enjoy summer's bounty of wine grapes, October is also Domestic Violence Awareness month which makes the partnership between Water 2 Wine and Gateway Women's Services even more pertinent.
